Key players of public and private seed sectors along with policy makers would help in discussing all possible initiatives to improve seed security in the country at this forum.

PSPA is extremely proud to invite you to the 2nd Pakistan Seed Congress at UAF on November 21-22, 2016. More than 1000 seed industry professionals, farmers, faculty, students and foreign delegates are expected to gather to share their expertise and knowledge for ensuring quality seed production in the country and the globe. An exhibition to showcase seeds and seed conditioning, warehousing and storage related equipments would be displayed during congress days.

Participation in Pakistan Seed Congress is not open to everyone. You can register if you are involved in seed business and research activities. Only limited students are allowed to attend this event

WHO CAN REGISTER AS AN EXHIBITOR?

Public sector, national and international seed organizations are highly encouraged to showcase their products and technologies. The number of exhibit booths is limited and allocation of space will be done on a first-come, first served basis. However, organizing committee will be responsible for the approval of submissions. The cost of each stall having dimension of 3x3 m2 would be PKR 10,000. The last date to book a stall in the exhibition is November 01, 2016.



POSTER COMPETITION

People from public and private sectors including graduate students are highly encouraged to participate in poster competition. The winners will be awarded with prizes in the concluding ceremony of congress.

AWARDS AND HONORS

THE LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP AWARD

The Executive Committee of PSPA is empowered to honour those who have made exceptional contributions to the society, by conferring upon them an Honorary Life Membership. This honor may be bestowed on not more than one member per year and may not be awarded to current members of the Executive Committee.

SEED EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Public sector, national and multinational seed companies who participated in seed congress and seed expo will qualify to apply for seed excellence award by evaluation committee proposed by executive committee. National and International seed companies will compete in their own category.

SEED MERIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS

On the basis of excellence performance of students who are working in the area of seed science during M.Sc (Hons.) will be awarded one scholarship. The applications will be called from students on yearly basis (before seed congress) and one scholarship will be awarded in each seed congress.

HOW TO REACH FAISALABAD?

Faisalabad is well-connected with other cities in the country by air, rail and road. For air travel, flights operate daily between Faisalabad (airport known as Lyallpur) and Karachi. Alternately, one may take international flight for Lahore or Islamabad, which are at $2\,\%$ and 4 hours drive, respectively, by motorway. Many trains shuttle between Faisalabad and Lahore.
